Trash Pick-Up on Wednesdays

Large Trash Pick-Up

- The District 4 office is responsible for the removal of your large trash debris once a month. You may place your items on the curb on the Monday of the first full week of the month.
- **Per ICC Board Policy, do NOT put out yard waste or items for pickup more than 5 days prior to the pickup.**
- The amount of debris that will be picked up at each house should fit into a standard pickup truck bed. If your debris exceeds this, please call the county office at 256-852-8351 to make special arrangements. A service charge of \$50 plus additional amount for disposal fees will be assessed by the Debris Collection Foreman.

Fine's Policy

- **FIRST NOTICE:** An initial notice of the violation shall be mailed via regular mail to the homeowner requesting compliance with the covenants within ten (10) days – **NO FINE.**
- **SECOND NOTICE:** If the violation still exists, a second notice requesting compliance within (10) days shall be mailed via regular mail to the homeowner – **NO FINE.**
- **THIRD NOTICE:** If the violation still exists, a **\$35.00 FINE** will be assessed. An invoice with the total fine due shall be mailed via regular mail to the homeowner. In addition, a **\$5.00 per day FINE** shall be assessed if the matter is not resolved within ten (10) days. The Board shall have the right to take legal action, the cost of which shall be billed to the homeowner and collected in the same manner as assessments.
- **CONTINUING VIOLATIONS:** If the same violation occurs within the year, the homeowner will be subject to another \$35.00 fine.
- **FINES:** No fines shall be imposed without first providing a written warning to the Owner describing the violation and stating that failure to stop the violation within no less than ten (10) days or **another recurrence of the same violation within twelve (12) months** of the original violation shall make the Owner **subject to imposition of a fine.** Failure to pay any fine shall subject the Owner to the same potential penalties and enforcement as failure to pay any assessments under the Covenants.

According to the Indian Creek Cove Covenants, only members in good standing may use the pool any time during open hours (9am-9pm). *Please, do not trespass after hours.* The ICC HOA **DOES NOT** employ a lifeguard and assumes **NO** responsibility for the safety of any persons using the pool.

All residents should be aware that the pool area is monitored by video surveillance devices which will be used to aid in the enforcement of the rules and in the prosecution of any crime. Refer to the Pool Rules on the Indian Creek Cove website for a complete listing.

spring yard CLEAN UP CHECKLIST

- Clean Up Leaves and Trash in Grass
- Pressure Wash Driveway, Porches, Sidewalks
- Pull Weeds in Garden Beds
- Add/Replace Soil/Mulch Re-Seed Grass
- Fertilize Grass
- Prune Dead Branches from Trees and Bushes
- Clean Garden Tools and Tune Up as Needed
- Wash Off Outdoor Furniture



- Permanent structures, extensions, ancillary buildings, fences, and obstructions require architectural review committee (ARC) approval prior to construction.
